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### **The 1300 Association Section 2020 Cancellation Notice and Refund Policy**

It is with heavy hearts that the art show has come to the decision to cancel the 2020 St. James Court Art Show. The 1300 Association's Co-Directors, being both show directors and exhibiting artists, understand how this decision impacts you. We sympathize and empathize with you. Please know that the decision was made with the artists', the art patrons' and the community's health and safety in mind.

The 2020 St. James Court Art Show in Louisville, Kentucky is cancelled:

- All booth fees will be refunded in full. You will receive your refund in the form of a check issued by The 1300 Association.
- The 1300 Association will not retain booth fees paid in 2020 to be credited to the 2021 Art Show. Booth fees for 2021 will remain the same.
- All artists invited by the jury in 2020 will receive an automatic invitation to the 2021 Art Show. Applications for new artists for The 1300 Association's section of the 2021 St. James Court Art Show will be accepted starting January 1, 2021. Current artists do not need to submit a new application.
- All 2020 confirmed artists will be posted as "Featured Artists" on the St. James Court Art Show website from September 1, 2020 until August 1, 2021. As "Featured Artists" you will have one image selected by the art show, along with your name, city, state, booth number and website address or email address. Information on how to participate will follow.

- All 2020 confirmed artists will be given the opportunity to participate in a “Virtual Art Show” on Saturday, October 3, 2020. More information on how to participate in the Virtual Art Show will follow.
